Oded established Longboard Vineyards in 1998, specializing in the production of premium wines mainly from the Russian River Valley appellation, he owns and lives on a vineyard on Westside Road just outside Healdsburg, where he grows Merlot, Malbec, Syrah and a few rows of other red varieties that go into the "DAKINE" Syrah blend.
