

There is a special place in my memory reserved for dry rosé wines, a place filled with sunsets on the sand dunes overlooking the surf rolling in at Hossegor (Western France). A place where chilly breezes bring in salty air mixed with whiffs of lavender and fresh-picked berries. A place radiating with a carefree love of life and the little pleasures it brings us when we take a pause.

The Longboard WATERGIRL ROSÉ is a perfect wine to reflect the great 2019 vintage in Northern California, a vintage that brought us both quality and quantity. Here, I used a combination of whole-cluster press and bleed lots from Mendocino Carignane, Russian River Valley Syrah and a bit of Pinot Noir and Grenache to layer a classy wine, helping you celebrate the coming spring and summer.

The wine was fermented in neutral (old) French oak barrels and finished bone-dry. This technique helps layer slight earthy notes over the strawberry, pear and melon fruit characters and make this a great wine to enhance your next food gathering.
